

SENA PARK



Sena Park is a Korean-born Paihia/Auckland-based artist who graduated from the University of Auckland with a Master of Fine Arts in 2015. Her cross-cultural background brings inspiration and motivation to her creative process. Her artistic creations are presented in 2D and 3D forms. Her works explore language through material relationships and connections that engage with colour, texture and symbolism.

Sena has completed artist residencies at the Swatch Art Peace Hotel in Shanghai and the 5th Land Art Mongolia 360° Biennial. In 2020 she was an artist-in-residence at Karekare House on the West Coast of Auckland (a partnership between the Eden Arts Trust and the Karekare House Trust), and she is currently participating in an Auckland Community Recycling Centre Art Residency.

Her work has appeared in exhibitions in Australia, Korea, China, Mongolia and Hungary, as well as locally at RM Gallery, Te Uru Waitakere Contemporary Gallery Window Space, Corban Estate Arts Centre, Comet Project Space, Corner Window Gallery in Auckland, and Weasel Gallery in Hamilton.
